

Gardening Uncovered: Alternative Christmas Trees

Choosing the perfect Christmas tree is no easy feat. So many colors, sizes and shapes to choose from can leave us checking measurements and trimming until we make it fit. Since Christmas in Florida often involves sand and beach adventures, Christmas trees are often nontraditional too. Arizona Cypress: This evergreen conifer is native to southwestern North America. A superior choice for Florida landscapes dues to its ability to handle less water and love for full sun. Growing at 1-2' per year, the Arizona Cypress is a great alternative Christmas Tree. Once mature, the tree can be 40-50' tall and 15-30' wide. The Arizona Cypress likes acidic, alkaline, loamy, sandy, welldrained soil. Its leaves come in different shades of green such as gray-green and blue-green.

Holly Trees: Holly is a versatile shrub that comes in many varieties and can withstand the heat and sun. Rooted in Celtic culture, holly has been a Christmas staple. Known also as a holy plant, Holly's deep green leaves and bright red berries make it a great canvas to add holiday lights and ornaments to. Holly can also be cut for floral arrangements, and shaped to be worn as crowns or can be made into wreaths.

Leyland Cypress: The hybrid hails from the West Coast redwood trees. Its deep, dark green boughs create a beautiful backdrop that makes ornaments pop. Thriving in warm climates, the Leyland Cypress will do great in well-drained soil as long as you don't overwater.

Cedar Trees: are great alternative to pine for Christmas trees. Their piney aroma, natural pyramid crown and low maintenance makes Cedar Trees ideal Christmas Trees. Their varied green needles lend the perfect backdrop for Christmas Décor.
